Description

The main goal of our project, "Let's meet again after the Covid-19 outbreak!", was to promote democracy, cooperation, and shared values in Europe through active local and international participation. It also aimed to promote mutual understanding of each other's cultures, showcase good practices, and plan for our future in the EU, solidarity, and problem-solving in the context of the pandemic. In addition to the traditional church history theme, this year's event also included activities presenting other topics. An important part of the project was to expand knowledge about the EU, promote communication between generations and nations, and strengthen tolerance and solidarity. We examined the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on the daily life of local communities in a conference, as well as the functioning of communities and forms of civic engagement during the Covid-19 crisis.

The project presented the process of cooperation with project partners by showcasing good practices. We brought together citizens of different ages as part of the project activities with the aim of helping them understand each other's social and political problems and discuss how local civil society organizations helped to resolve the pandemic situation.

The individual activities encouraged solidarity and volunteerism among the project participants.

During the implementation of the project, we made sure that the results of the project reached as many people as possible in each participating country. Representatives from three countries participated in the project: three partners from Hungary, one partner from Romania, and the applicant partner from Slovakia. Unfortunately, our Polish partner withdrew from the project in the last week, so more people from the town of Veresegyház attended the event.

The following activities were carried out as part of the project:

Arrival of guests, accommodation, mayor's greeting

Introduction of twin towns - workshop - presentations - good practices of the operation of local governments, exchange of experience.

Attention-grabbing lecture for citizens of all ages - "Should we be afraid of new epidemics" - post-epidemic depression and its prevention - Medical advice.

Discussion on the impact of COVID 19 on local communities - Seniors Club, the social and psychological impact of the pandemic on the elderly.

Presentation of the work of the communities as a call for civic engagement - workshop for civic activists (scouts, hunting club, retirement club, music school, choir, parish volunteers) EUCINEMA – film presentation of twin towns

02/08/2025 - Saturday - Day of culture and gastronomy

Selfie-point - registration with a photo for the event

EU DIRECT – information tent about the EU, preparation of a questionnaire with the participants about the EU (evaluation divided by gender)

Presentation of international gastronomic traditions - preparation of pork belly delicacies on an open fire, project partners also prepare their traditional dishes. Prizes for the best dishes.

The beauties of nature along the Ipoly river - an exhibition of the works of the local art school EU4CHILDRENS – children's programs, folk games, puppet theatre, fairy-tale games, crafts, with Polish, Transylvanian, Hungarian and Slovak folk tales.

Colourful folklore – a colourful folklore program presenting the traditions and folk costumes of the folklore groups of the region and sister settlements

Serious music concerts in the local church with renowned performers

EUPOPROCK - light music and rock music concerts with international performers

03/08/2025 Sunday - Day of historical commemorations and togetherness

Historical commemoration of the II. World War about the refugee soldiers from Katyn, Poland, laying a wreath at the local memorial.

The opening ceremony of the Holy Crown celebration on the main square, followed by the presentation of an authentic copy of the Hungarian royal Holy Crown to the participants, and its transport in a ceremonial procession with a 30-horse escort to the chapel, where there will be a festive service in honor of the Holy Crown.

Festive lunch with the guests, followed by the closing speech of the event.
